REQUIREMENTS:

Substantial empirical research experience in at least one of the areas of family, reproduction, health, employment or attitudes as well as very good knowledge and experience in the application of quantitative methods of empirical social research desirable. International academic experience (e.g. conferences, guest stays) is desirable. Experience in the acquisition of third-party funding or in academic selfadministration is an advantage. Last but not least, you should enjoy passing on your knowledge in teaching and trying out new teaching formats. Advanced knowledge of English and at least intermediate knowledge of German (for dealing with administrative matters and in teaching) are expected.

Research and teaching at the Chair of Life Course Sociology focusses on structure and change in individual life courses and their institutional contexts. We focus on family, employment and reproduction as well as welfare states, in particular social, family and reproduction policy.
