A prerequisite is several years of exhibition experience through numerous exhibitions and publications in internationally active public institutions such as museums, art associations, public exhibition houses or also in renowned private galleries or collector museums. Additionally, you have the potential for teaching excellence. Social and leadership skills and the willingness to participate in academic self-administration complete your profile. Moreover, the recruitment requirements in Sections 36 and 37 of the North Rhine-Westphalia Higher Education Act (Gesetz über die Hochschulen des Landes Nordrhein-Westfalen, HG) apply.
