Applicants should contribute to interdisciplinary collaborative research projects within and outside TU Dortmund University. Applicants for the W3 professorship are distinguished by their integration into leading international research networks.

Experience in raising or applying for third-party funds is expected. Applicants for the W3 professorship can already demonstrate success in independent raising of competitive third-party funding, including joint projects.

An appropriate contribution to the department's curriculum is expected.

The successful candidate will possess social and leadership skills and be willing to be involved in academic self-governance.

The recruitment requirements are based on § 36 and § 37 HG NRW (law governing universities in NRW).
