We are seeking an outstanding personality who, on the strength of pertinent publications in international peer-reviewed journals, can drive the international visibility of the field of theory-based empirical economic research. For the W2 professorship with W3 tenure track, we expect at least one very good publication or an outstanding publication that has reached at least the revise and resubmit stage. Furthermore, for the W3 professorship, an outstanding publication and a further very good publication are required. Candidates must also have a good knowledge of methods in applied econometrics (reduced form) or structural assessments.

Applicants will contribute to collaborative research projects within and outside TU Dortmund University. Willingness to raise third-party funds is essential.

The successful candidate should also engage in doctoral training, especially at the Ruhr Graduate School in Economics.

An appropriate contribution to the faculty's curriculum in English and in the medium term in German is expected.

The successful candidate will possess social and leadership skills and be willing to participate in academic self-governance.

Preconditions for employment are specified in § 36 and § 37 HG NRW (law governing universities in North-Rhine Westphalia).

In the case of the W2 professorship with W3 tenure track, the successful candidate will initially be appointed as a temporary civil servant for five years. At the end of this five-year period at the latest, the tenure track will lead to continued employment as a tenured W3 university professor, provided that the necessary aptitude, competence and academic performance have been demonstrated and that the legal requirements pertaining to § 38 HG NRW are met.

TU Dortmund University strives to increase the number of women in academic research and teaching and therefore explicitly encourages women to apply.
