You have cooperated (nationally and/or internationally) with relevant music institutions and music organizations (radio and television stations, festivals, opera and concert houses, music production companies, etc.). Vocational experience, as author, presenter, editor or producer in various formats of relevant music journalistic media (film, television, radio, CD, print, online media) is desirable. Additionally, you have the potential for teaching excellence and possess initial teaching experience. Social and leadership skills and the willingness to participate in academic self-administration complete your profile. Moreover, the recruitment requirements of Sections 36 and 37 of the North Rhine-Westphalia Higher Education Act (*Gesetz über die Hochschulen des Landes Nordrhein-Westfalen*, HG) apply.
